celebration was held to help VIC's oldest member **Tommy Norfolk** mark his 94th

organised by our Outreach Worker Claire Wright who arranged for Tommy's regimental association to provide him with a new tie, a regimental badge and buttons for a new blazer, which was paid for by members of VIC.

Operations Manager Bob Elliott said: "It was a lovely celebration for Tommy

"Tommy entertained us all by singing a song and Lewis Banham. another VIC member who is 94 in November, joined in."

Tommy, who lives in sheltered

accommodation in Urmston, met Claire when he was singing on stage at an event in Longford Park, Stretford.

He was 18 when he left his job in 1940 to enlist initially in the Dorset Regiment.

After he completed his training at

Bournemouth, he then joined the Manchester Regiment and was posted to North Africa where in 1942 he joined the 2nd Special Air Service.

He carried out around 100 parachute jumps.

He also served in

Italy, Sicily and Austria.

Tommy is now one of the few survivors left from the Second World War.

At the party, Tommy also met Fred Wellman, 85, who served in the Dorset Regiment after the war. at a later time
